

## Buddhism

Buddhism is a most wonderful path of mind purification founded by Siddhartha Gautama. Buddhism has three main schools of thought and practice named Sutrayana, Mahayana and Tantrayana. The three paths seek the same objective that is to purify the mind to a point of perfect clarity where there is a direct realization that there is no-mind, or what they term Buddha mind or Enlightenment.

Sutrayana makes emphasis on Buddha's precepts and sutras, recitation of mantras and meditation.

Mahayana makes emphasis in living in the present moment, direct observation and meditation also known as Zen

Tantrayana combines both previous schools and add some Yogic and Taoist techniques. They also have practices in a similar ancient Egyptians magical ceremonies that consist in uniting with deities =Tantra.

The final goal for all the schools is to achieve Enlightenment to then achieve Nirvana or final liberation from the wheel of death and rebirth. Buddhism is not a religion, but a beautiful philosophy that have been maintained pure through the pass of the centuries.

### Shortcomings of this philosophy from our perspective:

- 1- There is no believe in God
- 2- They believe in Nirvana the same level of consciousness realized by the Yogi and Jnani in which individuality is surrender into the formless absolute.
- 3- Tantrayana path also believe that they can transform their bodies into what they term "rainbow body". What actually happens is that the metal body is immortalized through purification and inner yoga or energy work (This is not Ascension) and they abide in that body in the highest heaven or the Buddha Lands, where they teach many sentient beings how to reach nirvana and the end of suffering. When you are at this level without surrendering your individuality you are called a Bodhisattva. Even in that place there is not a relationship to God. There is no God for them, only Nirvana that in reality we know now is in truth the presence of God.
- 4- Even if the individual achieves Enlightenment, that is transcending the mind, there is no God to be found as the have never seek Him, there is only liberation from all human tendencies that cause suffering.

Although this is a very pure path, without God in their hearts and the ability to sustain a relationship with Him, the followers of this path are missing the divine purpose

upon which each soul was created by God: Eternal Infinite Evolution without limits.  
Nirvana compare to the possibility to have an Eternal relationship with God is like  
comparing bread to a bakery fill of countless desserts.
